☺ **CMSP (County Medical Services Program) 1-877-699-6868**

Coverage for emergency hospitalization (including undocumented persons), for those of eligible income; apply in person at 2550 Paulin Dr, Santa Rosa.

A full medical, dental and vision insurance program for children who are legal California residents and whose parents meet income requirements; picks up where Medi-Cal eligibility leaves off. Health, vision, and dental insurance for children who do not qualify for Medi-Cal or Healthy Families and meet the income guidelines. This program is available to undocumented children ages birth up to 19 years old.

Medical, dental and vision coverage for legal California residents. The children's Medi-Cal application does not include family assets such as cars, homes and property, or bank accounts. **Health Insurance for Pregnant Women**

☺ **AIM (Access for Infants and Mothers)** 1-800-433-2611

Pregnancy-only coverage for mid-income pregnant women. Woman must apply before the 30<sup>th</sup> week of pregnancy. Family pays 1.5% of their adjusted gross income for services.

☺ **Pregnancy Medi-Cal** 1-877-699-6868

Pregnancy-only-related services for women, regardless of legal resident status; the application does not take into account family assets such as cars, homes and property, or bank accounts. Certified application assistors (CAAs) are available throughout Sonoma County to expedite the application: call 1-800-880-5305 to find one in your community.
