Interrupting the transmission of intergenerational trauma within our community — Science clearly shows that social inequity and systemic racism are critical root causes of disease and can be passed within communities and between generations through adverse childhood events (ACEs) and trauma. We envision a critical role for community health centers to support and facilitate community co-designed projects that address systemic barriers and can support meaningful policies and programs using the 'Self-Healing Community' model of change.

Health Center of the Future – We are thrilled that construction on the new Russian River Health & Wellness Center in Guerneville has begun and will become an integrated hub for health and wellbeing. Medical, dental and behavioral health will be provided in one location and continue to serve some of our most vulnerable neighbors. Large group rooms within the site have been designed to foster wellness, movement, and education classes as well as convening spaces for community co-design.
